

Power of Work is a program designed to provide career services for individuals receiving TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) and SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) benefits. Our participants are assigned to professional career coaches and given skills assessments and job readiness training so they are able to smoothly transition into employment.
